It is a popular tourist destination, with a thriving arts scene and many small businesses. Levels of deprivation are higher than average and 9.7% (8,600) children live in poverty. The city has two universities and a student population of around 40 000. Although it has fewer children under 19 years than average, it has a young and growing population. It has the largest proportion of same sex couples in England, and 14% of adults are gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender.</p> <p>The Public Health team is responsible for ensuring health, wellbeing and reduction in inequalities in health are put at the centre of the city council's policies. The advise and commission the delivery of public health services from a variety of agencies, including sport centres, schools, Brighton & Hove Food partnership.</p>
